### TRASH

- Carts to curb by 6am
- All trash in tied trash bags
- Carts should be easily accessible by trucks (clear 3ft around cart)
- General household items only

# LEAF & LIMB

- **(V)** Cut limbs in 8 foot pieces
- Avoid making piles under power lines
- Leaves can be in piles or bags
- Call (501) 279-1000 to schedule pickup
- Residents may pick up free mulch at the Mulch Center located at 1840 North Main Street

## **RECYCLING**

- (V) Plastic Bottles
  - Clear & colored beverage bottles
  - Milk & juice jugs
  - Ketchup, mayonnaise, mustard bottles
  - Liquid soap & detergent bottles
  - Lotion and shampoo bottles
  - · Plastic coffee containers
- ( Aluminum & Tin Cans
  - Empty contents and rinse clean.
     Metal lids can be dropped into the opened can. Labels do not need to be removed.
